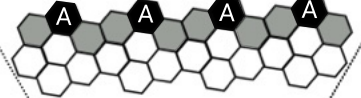


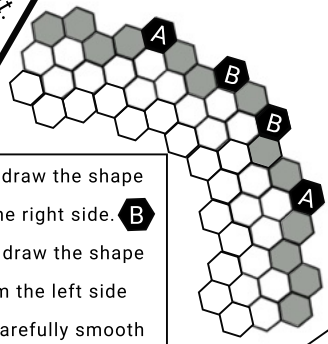
1. Align this to the middle of each hexagon that sticks out the most in the border **A**

This template is for adding a scalloped edge to a 1.5" (measured side) hexagon quilt. Tested on size of 7 flowers per side plus one row of hexies as a border to cut into (lightly shaded in template). making one large hexagon shaped quilt. For the corners, draw the shape around the single protuding hexie **A** that butts up to the corner of 3 hexies in a row. Then draw the shape from the right side. **B** Next, draw the shape from the left side and carefully smooth where they overlap.
